





ICP Latam Accreditation Process

Not all schools are eligible for ICP Latam accreditation. Schools must comply, commit to, and uphold the ICP Latam Code of Best School Practices (Accreditation Standards) to be eligible to receive and maintain ICP Latam accreditation. The ICP Latam accreditation standards consist of six fundamental principles that encapsulate the elements that build and maintain the trust of consumers and students.

To be eligible for ICP Latam accreditation, each school must complete an accreditation application. Upon receiving the duly completed application, ICP Latam staff will:

Review the application.

Investigate the school and its directors.

Verify the accuracy of the information contained in the application.

May request additional information.

Can request evidence of specific information contained in the application.

After the review and verification process, ICP Latam will assess whether the school complies with the ICP Latam Code of Best School Practices (Accreditation Standards). Once ICP Latam has completed its evaluation process, the accreditation application will be approved or denied. If the applicant is in compliance with the Code of Best School Practices, it will be presented to the ICP Latam Council for final approval. If the application is denied, ICP Latam will communicate with the applicant, providing the reasons for the decision as well as the available appeal resources.
